

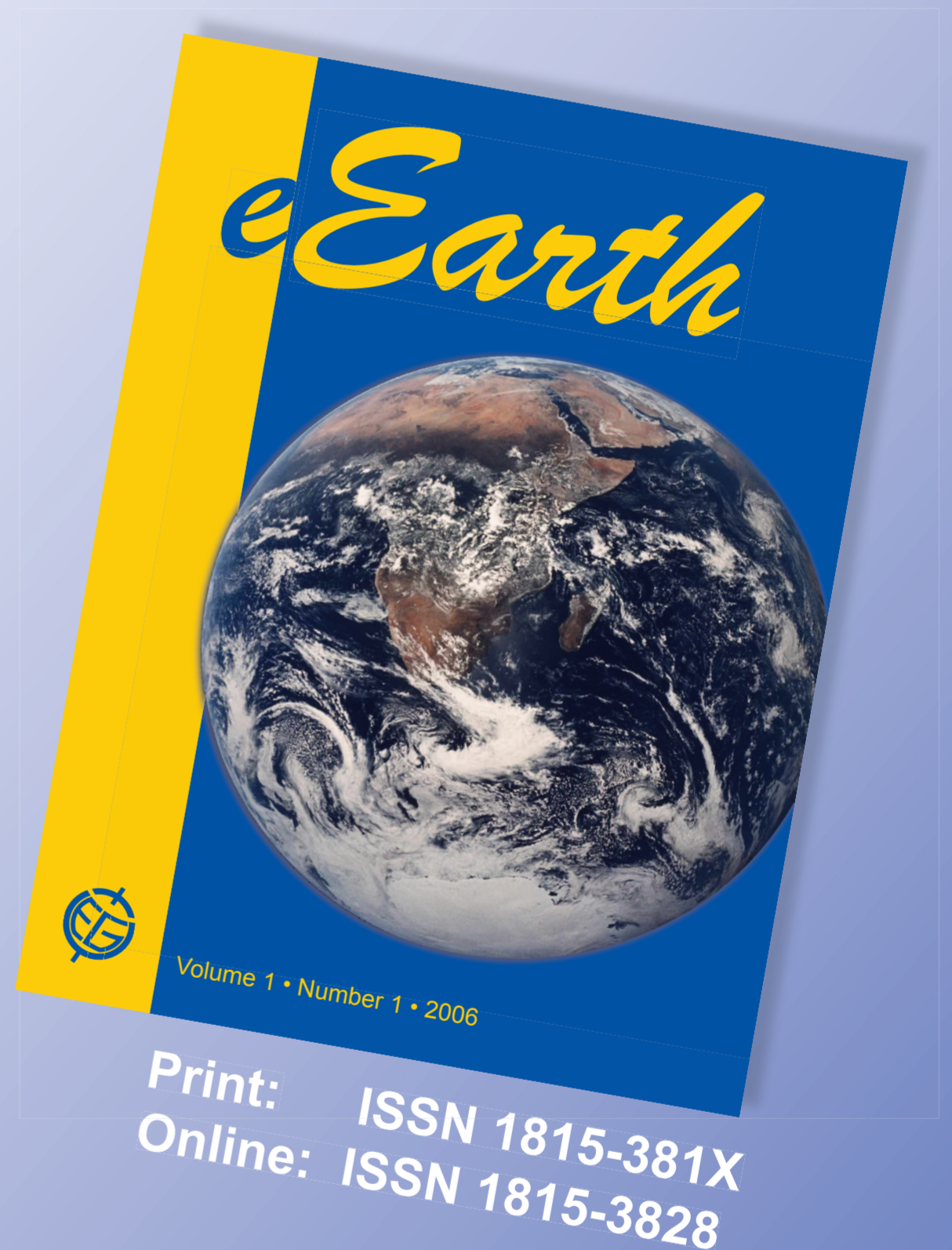

Aims and Scope

eEarth uses an open access interactive format to publish **short, topical papers** in all disciplines of the Earth Sciences. Its scope ranges from processes in the deep interior of the Earth and the terrestrial planets; magmatism, metamorphism and volcanism; the creation, deformation and destruction of lithosphere; fluids, fluxes, and reservoirs of mineral and energy resources; surface processes such as erosion, transport, deposition of sediments and resulting geomorphology; and the response of the Earth to climate change. **The length of papers is limited to four journal pages, which corresponds to about 3000 words, a maximum of 30 references and no more than 5 figures and tables.**
